Regulations for Recommendations for the 65th Electrical Science and Engineering Promotion Awards

1. Grant and the Number of Awards

The total amount of grant is within 4 million yen and the amount of grant and the number of award winners is finalized by the Committee of Electrical Science and Engineering Promotion Awards, conferring a certificate of merit, a commemorative shield, and a fixed amount of grant.

From among the awarded applicants, in addition to The Electrical Science and Engineering Promotion Awards, “Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Minister's Award” shall be conferred upon one winner specially selected and “Electrical Science and Engineering Promotion” President Award shall be conferred upon the following excellent award recipient.

2. Eligible Applicants

Eligible applicants are those who have obtained outstanding achievement in invention, research, actual utilization, software development, or education, etc., and contribute to the industrial developments and the betterment of people’s lives, and are expected to continue to realize remarkable achievement even after the award-winning in the following fields of electrical science engineering.

The fields in which awards are conferred are electricity, industry and transportation including manufacturing, automobile and its related field, consumer products, information and communication including software development, education including technical assistance and instruction.

3. Requirements for Applicants

- a. Those who have worked for a total of ten years and more, as a general rule.
- b. The number of candidates shall be three and less for one theme
- c. The number of recommended theme from the same company or organization shall be three and less, and one recommendation in the same field.
- d. Those who have never been awarded in public settings in the recommended field.
Awards in public settings are, in addition to our awards, Minister Awards, Governor Awards and such authoritative ones. Those who have been honored with these public awards under his or her individual name in the same theme cannot be recommended. However, people awarded by their company or firm can be recommended.
- e. Those who have not been awarded due to the limited numbers of winners in spite of the

fact that they have been outstandingly diligent for many years of service and have been playing an important role based on the past awarded theme in public settings in the field of electrical science and engineering.

f. No recommendations deviating from the above-mentioned regulations can be accepted.

4. Selection of Winners

The Committee of the Electrical Science and Engineering Promotion Awards will decide on winners after it examines recommendations submitted by corporations or educational organizations based on the contents in their recommendation documents with a major emphasis on higher levels of technology and practical value and greater effects to society and economy. Since the selections are conducted separately according to the following five fields, the application field proposed by the recommender should be indicated by checking one of them printed on the Recommendation Form for Engineering and Related Field.

1. electricity
2. industry and transportation
3. consumer product
4. information and communication
5. Education.

The Committee, however, will finalize the field.

5. Deadline of Recommendation

Recommendation Forms must arrive by Friday, June 30, 2017

6. Number of Recommendation Forms for Submission

Five sets of Recommendation Forms and additional papers (one original and four copies are acceptable). Submission of the official Recommendation Forms, strictly A4 size only, downloaded from the website would be highly appreciated for paperwork.

Winners and their recommenders will be informed directly during the middle of October, 2017. *OHM*, the general technology journal and other monthly magazines published by Ohmsha, Ltd. will carry an article on the awards. The awarding ceremony is scheduled to be held in late November.

Any submitted documents will not be returned. The contents described in the recommendation documents including private information shall be used only for the selection of the awards.

Winners, however, are posted on the list of winners, which will be distributed by the Promotion Foundation for Electrical Science and Engineering and are also introduced in *OHM*, the general technology journal published by Ohmsha, Ltd.

Winners may receive information on lectures or other events conducted by the Promotion Foundation for Electrical Science and Engineering after the selection.
